



Regulation 4

CHARGES FOR ACCOMMODATION, MAINTENANCE AND TREATMENT

Column 1 Item No.	Column 2 Class of Patient.	Column 3 Charge
1.	In-patient who is a hospital insured patient and elects to be treated by a salaried medical practitioner:	
	(a) where occupying a private bed	\$100 per day
	(b) where occupying a bed (not being a private bed)	\$75 per day
2.	In-patient who elects to be treated by a medical practitioner who is not a salaried medical practitioner:	
	(a) where occupying a private bed	\$75 per day
	(b) where occupying a bed (not being a private bed)	\$50 per day".
