| Interpretation               | 1. Regulation 2(1) of the Special Purposes Leases Regulations is amended by inserting in the definition of "qualified person" after "association" the words, "statutory corporation established under a law of the Commonwealth or of a State or Territory,".  |
| Form of application          | 2. Regulation 4(1) of the Special Purposes Leases Regulations is amended by inserting after "lease" the words, "other than a lease within the Darwin Town Area or a municipality,".  |
| General conditions of leases | 3. Regulation 5(j) of the Special Purposes Leases Regulations is amended by omitting "dollars per centum" and substituting "per cent".   |
| The Schedule                 | 4. Form 1 of the Schedule to the Special Purposes Leases Regulations is amended by— <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>(a) inserting after "undertakes to pay" the words, "if the land is not within the Darwin Town Area or a municipality,"; and</li> <li>(b) omitting "herewith the sum of 3 dollars as application fee" and substituting "the application fee of 3 dollars in accordance with regulation 4(1)".</li> </ul> |
