AMENDMENTS OF THE SPECIAL PURPOSES LEASES REGULATIONS

Interpretation

1. Regulation 2(1) of the Special Purposes Leases Regulations is amended by inserting in the definition of "qualified person" after "association" the words, "statutory corporation established under a law of the Commonwealth or of a State or Territory,".

Form of application

General conditions of leases

The Schedule 2. Regulation 4(1) of the Special Purposes Leases Regulations is amended by inserting after "lease" the words, "other than a lease within the Darwin Town Area or a municipality,".

3. Regulation 5(j) of the Special Purposes Leases Regulations is amended by omitting "dollars per centum" and substituting "per cent".

4. Form 1 of the Schedule to the Special Purposes Leases Regulations is amended by—

- (a) inserting after "undertakes to pay" the words, "if the land is not within the Darwin Town Area or a municipality,"; and
- (b) omitting "herewith the sum of 3 dollars as application fee" and substituting "the application fee of 3 dollars in accordance with regulation 4(1)".
