Regulations under the *Parole of Prisoners Ordinance*

PAROLE OF PRISONERS (FEES AND ALLOWANCES) REGULATIONS

1. These Regulations may be cited as the Parole of Prisoners (Fees and Allowances) Regulations. Citation

2.(1) Subject to sub-regulation (2), a member of the Board who is entitled to receive remuneration under section 3D of the Ordinance shall be paid, in respect of each day on which he attends a meeting of the Board — Fees

- (a) in the case of the Chairman, a fee of 60 dollars; and
- (b) in the case of any other member, a fee of 54 dollars.

(2) Where a meeting does not continue for more than 4 hours on any day, the amount payable, for each hour or part of an hour that the meeting has continued —

- (a) to the Chairman is 12 dollars; and
- (b) to another member is 10 dollars.

3.(1) Where a member of the Board who is entitled to receive remuneration under section 3D of the Ordinance is necessarily absent overnight from his place of residence in order to attend a meeting of the Board, he shall be paid an allowance of 45 dollars for each night he is so absent. Allowances and costs for absence from residence

(2) A member of the Board may be paid costs which, in the opinion of the Board, are reasonably incurred in travelling for a meeting of the Board.

4.(1) The Minister may pay a member of the Board who is entitled to receive remuneration under section 3D of the Ordinance and who became a member prior to the date of commencement of these Regulations — Allowance for past actions

*Parole of Prisoners (Fees and Allowances) Regulations*

- (a) an allowance, as determined by the Board; and
- (b) costs which, in the opinion of the Board, were reasonably incurred,

in respect of any meeting the member attended from 9 September 1977 to and including the day immediately before the commencement of these Regulations.

(2) An allowance paid to a member under sub-regulation (1) shall not be more than the remuneration that would have been payable to him for attending those meetings of the Board if these Regulations had come into operation on 9 September 1977.
