AMENDMENTS OF THE ELECTRICITY (FEES AND CHARGES)
REGULATIONS

1. Regulation 5 of the Electricity (Fees and Charges) Regulations is repealed and the following regulation substituted:

Charges for
street lighting
supply

"5. Subject to regulation 7, the annual charge payable to the Commission by a consumer for the supply of electricity to a street light is the charge specified in Schedule 3 in respect of that street light."
