AMENDMENTS OF THE HOSPITALS AND MEDICAL SERVICES (CHARGES) REGULATIONS

Election by
in-patients

1. Regulation 5A of the Hospitals and Medical Services (Charges) Regulations is amended by omitting paragraph (b) and substituting the following paragraph:

“(b) state whether he is a hospital insured person; and”.

CHARGES FOR ACCOMMODATION, MAINTENANCE AND TREATMENT

Column 1	Column 2	Column 3
Item No.	Class of patient	Charge
1	In-patient who is a hospital insured patient and elects to be treated by a salaried medical practitioner:	
	(a) where occupying a private bed.....	\$80 per day
	(b) where occupying a bed (not being a private bed)	\$60 per day
2	In-patient who elects to be treated by a medical practitioner who is not a salaried medical practitioner:	
	(a) where occupying a private bed.....	\$60 per day
	(b) where occupying a bed (not being a private bed)	\$40 per day.”.
