AMENDMENTS OF THE PUBLIC HEALTH (SHOPS, EATING-HOUSES, BOARDING-HOUSES, HOSTELS AND HOTELS) REGULATIONS

1. These Regulations shall come into operation on 1 January 1979.

2. Regulations 10 and 50 of the Public Health (Shops, Eating-Houses, Boarding-Houses, Hostels and Hotels) Regulations are amended by omitting "Commonwealth of Australia Gazette" and substituting "Gazette".

3. An action duly taken or done before the commencement of these Regulations savings under or for the purposes of a provision of the Public Health (Shops, Eating-Houses, Boarding-Houses, Hostels and Hotels) Regulations and having effect immediately before the commencement of these Regulations is as valid and effectual as if duly made, taken or done under or for the purposes of that provision as amended by these Regulations, but any action that may be taken or done in respect of an action made, taken or done under or for the purposes of that provision as amended by these Regulations may be taken or done in respect of that first-mentioned action.
