## Regulations under the Public Health Act

## AMENDMENTS OF THE PUBLIC HEALTH (INFECTIOUS AND NOTIFIABLE DISEASES) REGULATIONS

Commencement

1. These Regulations shall come into operation on 1 January, 1979.

Definitions

2. Regulation 2 of the Public Health (Infectious and Notifiable Diseases) Regulations is amended by omitting from the definition of "occupier" the words "the surface of any land belonging to the Commonwealth" and substituting "the surface of any land belonging to the Territory or the Commonwealth".

Treatment of dogs

3. Regulation 29(2) of the Public Health (Infectious and Notifiable Diseases) Regulations is amended by omitting "the Commonwealth shall not incur any liability" and substituting "the Territory shall not incur any liability".

Savings

4. An action duly taken or done before the commencement of these Regulations under or for the purpose of a provision of the Public Health (Infectious and Notifiable Diseases) Regulations and having effect immediately before the commencement of these Regulations is as valid and effectual as if duly made, taken or done under or for the purposes of that provision as amended by these Regulations, but any action that may be taken or done in respect of an action made, taken or done under or for the purposes of that provision as amended by these Regulations may be taken or done in respect of that first-mentioned action.
