Regulations under the Mines Regulation Act

AMENDMENTS OF THE MINES (RADIATION PROTECTION) REGULATIONS

1. These Regulations shall come into operation on 1 January 1979.

2. Regulation 2(1) of the Mines (Radiation Protection) Regulations is amended — Interpretation

- (a) by inserting before the definition of "Code" the following definition: " 'Chief Medical Officer' means the Chief Medical Officer appointed under the Public Health Act;"; and
- (b) by omitting the definition of "Director of Health".

3. Regulations 2(3) (definition of "central health authority"), (5) and 4(1)(b) of the References to Mines (Radiation Protection) Regulations and Schedule 2 to those Regulations are amended by omitting "Director of Health" (wherever occurring) and substituting "Chief Medical Officer".

4. An action duly taken or done before the commencement of these Regulations savings under or for the purposes of a provision of the Mines (Radiation Protection) Regulations and having effect immediately before the commencement of these Regulations is as valid and effectual as if duly made, taken or done under or for the purposes of that provision as amended by these Regulations but any action that may be taken or done in respect of an action made, taken or done under or for the purposes of that provision as amended by these Regulations may be taken or done in respect of that first-mentioned action.
