Community Based Sentences (Interstate Transfer) Regulations 2023

1 Title

These Regulations may be cited as the *Community Based Sentences (Interstate Transfer) Regulations 2023.*

2 Commencement

- (1) These Regulations, other than regulation 4, commence on the commencement of section 28 of the *Community Based Sentences* (*Interstate Transfer*) *Act 2023.*
- (2) Regulation 4 commences on the commencement of Part 2 of the *Sentencing and Other Legislation Amendment Act 2022.*

3 Participating jurisdictions

For section 5 of the Act, definition *participating jurisdiction*, paragraph (b), each of the following is declared to be a participating jurisdiction:

- (a) the Australian Capital Territory;
- (b) New South Wales;
- (c) Queensland;
- (d) South Australia;
- (e) Tasmania;
- (f) Victoria;
- (g) Western Australia.

4 Community based sentences

For section 6(1)(a)(vii) of the Act, the following sentences are prescribed:

- (a) a community correction order made under Part 3, Division 4 of the *Sentencing Act 1995*;
- (b) an intensive community correction order made under Part 3, Division 5, Subdivision 2 of the *Sentencing Act 1995*.
