**1 Title**

These Regulations may be cited as the *Consumer Affairs and Fair Trading (Fuel Retailers) Amendment Regulations 2026*.

**2 Commencement**

These Regulations commence on 20 April 2026.

**3 Regulations amended**

These Regulations amend the *Consumer Affairs and Fair Trading (Fuel Retailers) Regulations 2017*.

**4 Regulation 5 replaced**

**5 Reporting for MyFuel NT**

- (1) In relation to each day on which the fuel retailer for a service station will offer prescribed fuel for retail sale at the service station, the fuel retailer is required to report to the Commissioner the normal fuel price that will apply to each prescribed fuel offered during the 24 hour period commencing at 6.00 am on that day.
- (2) A report under subregulation (1) must be made between 8.30 am and 2.00 pm on the day before the 24 hour period commences.
- (3) If, during the 24 hour period, the fuel retailer wishes to reduce the normal fuel price of a prescribed fuel, the fuel retailer is required to report to the Commissioner:
  - (a) the revised normal fuel price for the prescribed fuel, which must be lower than the price of the prescribed fuel at the time the report is made; and
  - (b) the time at which the revised normal fuel price is effective.
- (4) If a prescribed fuel offered for retail sale is temporarily unavailable, the fuel retailer is required to report that event to the Commissioner.

**5 Repeal of Regulations**

These Regulations are repealed on the day after they commence.
